Meeting Date: July 09, 2013**

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Terry Blake at 6:00 pm.

4. Staff Meeting:

Terry Blake reviewed the letter to the Historic District Committee, dated July 09, 2013, recommending disapproval of an application to demolish the barns at 168 Main Street. There was discussion among the members that resulted in agreement that the letter should be sent to the HDC.

Jennifer Madden moved to approve Historic Marker application for
170 Main Street-C.C.P. Waterman 1836.

The motion was seconded by Don Bayley and approved by a voice vote.

Bill Daley updated the SHC on the scheduling of historical reenactors for the 375th celebration. They will include Dartmouth's 1650's militia, possibly Wampanoag reenactors, Prospect Yarmouth Minute Men 1774 militia and Civil War reenactors to recreate the Sandwich Guards. There is an effort to coordinate a softball game with historic rules. There are plans to create a Dodge MacKnight exhibit.

Don Bayley read a letter he received from a trade publishing company offering to publish a picture book/ebook of Sandwich. Don said that he is not available to work on the project and offered the project to anyone or any group that might be interested in compiling photographs and stories for a book. Don and Bill expressed interest in working on the book in 2015.
