

MINUTES

Sandwich Historical Commission
September 3, 2014

Call to order: The meeting was called to order by the Chair, David Schrader, at 6:02 pm

Present: Members David Schrader, Bill Daley, Jennifer Madden, Carolyn Crowell, Don Bayley, Lisa Hassler

1. Review and Approval of Minutes:

Jennifer Madden moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of August 6, 2014. Don Bayley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Correspondence / Statements / Announcements / Follow Up:

David Schrader mentioned that he had received an email from Richard Davies regarding a demolition delay bylaw which he will address under old business.

3. Public Forum:

The following members of the public attended the meeting to speak at public forum: Don Stainbrook, Judith Stainbrook, Erin Sullivan, Carlo DiPersio, Tom Stanton. All are residents of the Pine Street/Grove Street/Shawme Road neighborhood. They were there to voice their concerns regarding the plans of Heritage Museums & Gardens to construct an attraction called Arial Adventure, as well as the road changes proposed at Pine Street, Grove Street and Pocasset Road. They sought advice from commission members regarding avenues they can pursue to halt these plans.

4. Staff Meeting:

Jennifer Madden reported that the work on the gravestones in the Old Town Burying Ground is almost complete. Also, an agreement has been signed regarding the preparation of a preservation master plan for Cedarville Cemetery and the firm hopes to begin work soon.

Lisa Hassler reported that the Board of Selectmen believes that CPC money can be used to restore the building. An RFQ is being prepared to have a preservation architect write a report about the building and explore possible future uses for the space.

Bill Daley reported that Don Amidon will now make the historic house marker signs. They will make them for the same price (\$80) as the previous maker, but reserve the right to increase the price if they feel it is necessary. The previous maker provided all instructions, fonts, etc. so the signs will look identical to ones previously made.

Historic house markers were approved for the following homes:

- 32 Jarves Street, Cornelius Donovan, c. 1857. Bill Daley moved and Don Bayley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.



- 14 Liberty Street, William Kern, 1830. Bill Daley and Jennifer Madden seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

6. Old Business:


