1. Review and Approval of Minutes:

Approval of the Minutes of July 2015 meeting. Moved by Bill Daley, seconded by Don Bayley, approved unanimously

Move to have Historical Commission send both letters made by Bill Daley, 2nd by Jennifer Madden, passes unanimously.

Discussion regarding Deacon Eldred House. Move to send letter of support for the town to maintain and preserve the façade of the building and to preserve its 18th century interior format. Moved by Bill Daley, 2nd by Lisa Hassler, passes unanimously.

Cedarville Cemetery: Jennifer Madden explains that Kaethe Maquire had reached out to the Wing family and other descendants of those buried in the cemetery for financial support and has had some success. The project also has \$15,000 from cemetery commission and support from CPC. The work will start in the spring.

5. New business: Committee Membership – The following people have expressed interest in joining the Historical Commission as members: Phil Austin, Brandon Carrico and Greg Anderson. Don Bayley moved to recommend to the Board of Selectmen that Greg Anderson serve for the remainder of Terry Blake’s term. Jennifer Madden seconded. Passed unanimously.
